In the quiet corners of Paraguay, Osvaldo's world was shadowed by the struggles of an alcoholic father. At 12 years old and seeking relief, Osvaldo found Awana in the midst of his family's challenges.

Osvaldo shares, "I have been coming to Awana since November to get to know Jesus. I am now participating as a leader and helping other children to also know Jesus. My family was lost. My dad was drinking a lot, which led me to come here to be a testimony."

Diving into the biblical programs offered by Awana, and engaging with Scripture, Osvaldo met Jesus Christ. As His relationship with Jesus deepened, so did the transformation within his family.

Osvaldo's newfound faith became a catalyst for change, making a remarkable impact on his family. His father, once trapped in addiction, found hope in the same source as Osvaldo: Jesus Christ. Praise God!




