What is Bible Quizzing?

OBJECTIVES:

To promote and encourage clubbers in Bible memorization and review of their handbook materials.

To provide a friendly, competitive atmosphere in which participants can display their Bible knowledge and gain a sense of accomplishment.

To give clubbers a greater love for and working knowledge of the Bible.



To provide an opportunity for adults to deeper relationships with their clubbers and to be an example of godliness to them.

To proclaim God's wonderful grace and salvation through Bible quiz questions. Parents and friends may then see their need of becoming a Christian and be challenged to accept Christ as Savior.

This event motivates students to increase their Bible knowledge while giving participants, leaders, and even parents an intense exposure to Scripture. Bible Quizzing tests students' knowledge of material in handbooks and provides team recognition and awards.

Bible Quizzing stimulates Scripture memorization, application of God's Word, and review. It also motivates students to stay up-to-date in their handbooks. As students spend more time preparing for Bible Quizzing, their parents also become exposed to the truths of God's Word. In addition, Bible Quizzing can promote fellowship with other churches.

In order to appeal to different types of clubbers, a Bible Quiz meet has four different methods of quizzing that can be used.

Individual Multiple Choice Quizzing – This method employs the use of quizzing paddles for answering multiple-choice questions. It also encourages timid clubbers to participate and gives greater incentive for learning and preparing while earning points for their team.

Team-Huddle Quizzing – This method challenges young people to know material well, to recall it quickly, and to respond accurately in front of an audience. The questions are answered by writing the answer on a white board and displaying the answer when called upon.

Written Quizzing – This method allows the clubbers to demonstrate their understanding of the material and the verses. The questions for the written portion of the quiz will be done on the day of the quiz. These will be multiple-choice, matching, or short answer style questions and spelling will not count.

Speed Quizzing – This method allows the youth to think quickly and act on their knowledge of the materials and the Word of God. These questions allow teams to discuss the question for 10 seconds and then one team member will stand and give the answer.

Combining multiple styles of quizzing into one Bible Quiz meet provides an excellent means of properly recognizing all clubbers' accomplishments.
