Uniform Financing Options

The uniform is an important component of the Awana® ministry. Under no circumstances do we want the cost of the uniform to interfere with a child being in Awana. While the cost of the uniform is reasonable and less than many other youth programs, there are ways to reduce the cost for families if necessary.

- Subsidize a portion of the cost of the uniform for kids from families in financial need.
- Get the children involved in paying for their uniforms. Suggest they do chores for relatives or for the church to earn money.
- When kids no longer need their uniforms, buy them back at half the original price and sell them at a discount to others.
- Ask an adult Sunday school class or adult small group to take on the ministry of subsidizing uniforms in a given club.
- Allow families to pay \$2.00 each week until the uniform is paid for.
- Contact the parents and discuss the importance of the Awana uni-form. Explain why a uniform is so essential to club and why it makes a huge difference to the child's success.
